## Taking Notes for Research

- Use 4 x 6 index cards for taking notes.
- Write notes related to one idea on each card.
- Include the following:
  - 1. Topic of notes in upper left hand corner
  - 2. Bibliography card number in upper right corner
- 3. Page number on which information was found in upper right corner
- Kinds of notes:

1. **Quotation**: For a passage that is particularly significant or well-stated, you may quote it word for word. Be sure to use quotation marks.

2. **Paraphrase:** Restate particular ideas or pieces of information from a small section in your own words.

3. **Summary**: To record the general idea of a long paragraph, several paragraphs, or a chapter, summarize in your own words.

4. **Statistics or Percentages** – Specific data should be represented accurately and be explained.
